Reading stories with your child

- **1. Find a quiet space** for you and your child.
- 2. Look at the front cover of the book and talk about what you see in the picture. Wonder aloud what you think the story might be about.
- 3. Take a 'picture walk' through the book and talk about what you see in the pictures.
- 4. As you read the story **discuss questions** such as:
 - Who, what, when, where, why
 - What do you think about....
 - I wonder
 - What do you think happens next?
- 5. Relate events in the story to your child's life
 - For example, 'Do you remember when we went to the zoo/countryside/shop?'
- 7. Discuss the meanings of words, e.g. position words (up, down, next to, behind, beside etc.) or unusual words You could act them out with your child or look up the meanings on google or in a dictionary.
